Our schedule and contract with the facility is based on the assumption that most attendees will stay both nights. However, if you can only attend for one night, we welcome your participation and ask that you note this on the registration form.

Your meals and lodging costs are covered by the Chapter. If you have a guest/family member that you would like to bring, please indicate this on the registration form. We are happy to accommodate them for a charge of \$75 per guest/family member to cover catering costs. However, please note that we can only accommodate a limited number of private rooms and guests, and that this is a working retreat with a full agenda. We will, however, have down time scheduled in the evenings as well as afternoon breaks to enjoy the grounds. If you would like to extend your stay with Menucha (or arrive early), please make your arrangements directly with the venue.

Outside alcoholic beverages are permitted at the venue. Our group will be staying at Ballard Hall, which contains two floors of dormitory rooms, meeting space, and a kitchen/lounge.

Please return the enclosed registration and *Participant Voluntary Assumption of Risk* forms (signed & dated) to the Chapter office by **July 31st**. Even if you can't attend, we appreciate you returning the registration form to let us know. Members who have attended past retreats left feeling energized, connected to the Chapter, and enjoyed the opportunity to build relationships with other Board members in a beautiful setting.
