Nominations and Leadership Identification Committee

The Nominations Committee is authorized by Article IX: Committee and Taskforces of the NASW Oregon Chapter Bylaws and the NASW Oregon Chapter Board of Directors.

Time Frame

July 1 through June 30.

Composition

- A. The Committee composition shall be representative of the chapter's five regions.
- B. The term of the office of members shall be two years, and terms shall be staggered.
- C. Committee members shall not be eligible to run for election or be appointed to a Chapter Board of Directors position until one year after his or her term expires or his or her resignation.
- D. The Chair shall be elected by the membership during the general election or selected by members of the Committee from among those serving in the last year of their term.

Responsibility

The Committee is responsible for conducting the chapter's nominations, selection, and election process in accordance with the *Standards for NASW Chapter Nominations and Elections*.

Accountability

- The Committee is accountable to the chapter board of directors.
- The Committee shall carry out its duties related to the selection of candidates as an autonomous body.
- The Committee is subject to the policies set forth in the NASW Oregon Bylaws, *Standards for NASW Chapter Nominations and Elections* and by the Chapter Board of Directors.

Qualifications

- Membership in NASW Oregon.
- Knowledge of and commitment to NASW and the Chapter.
- Interest in/evidence of active involvement and leadership in Chapter activities.
- Availability to fulfill the duties of the office.

Time Commitment

December through April: Three to six hours per month.

May through November: One to two hours per month.
