

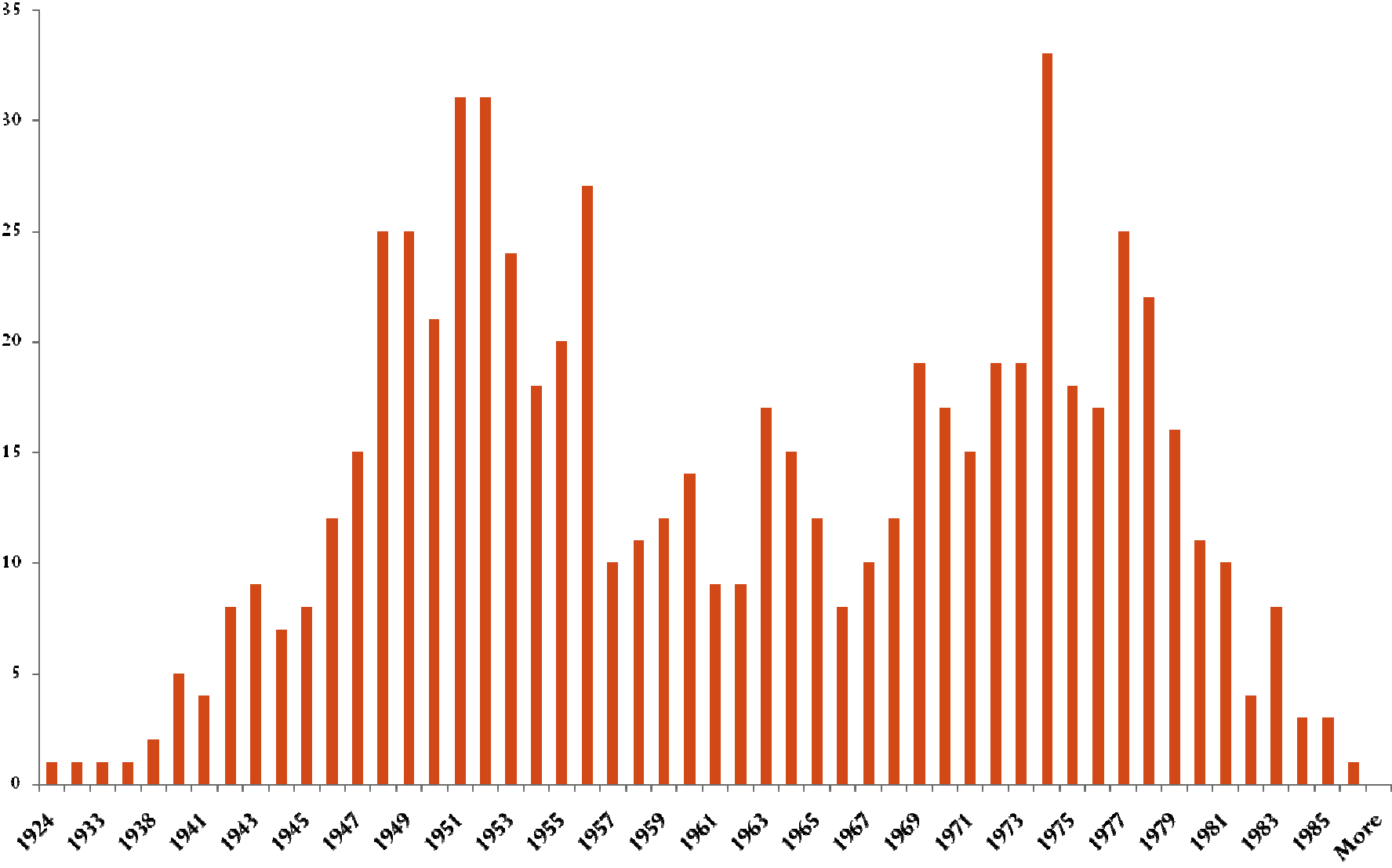

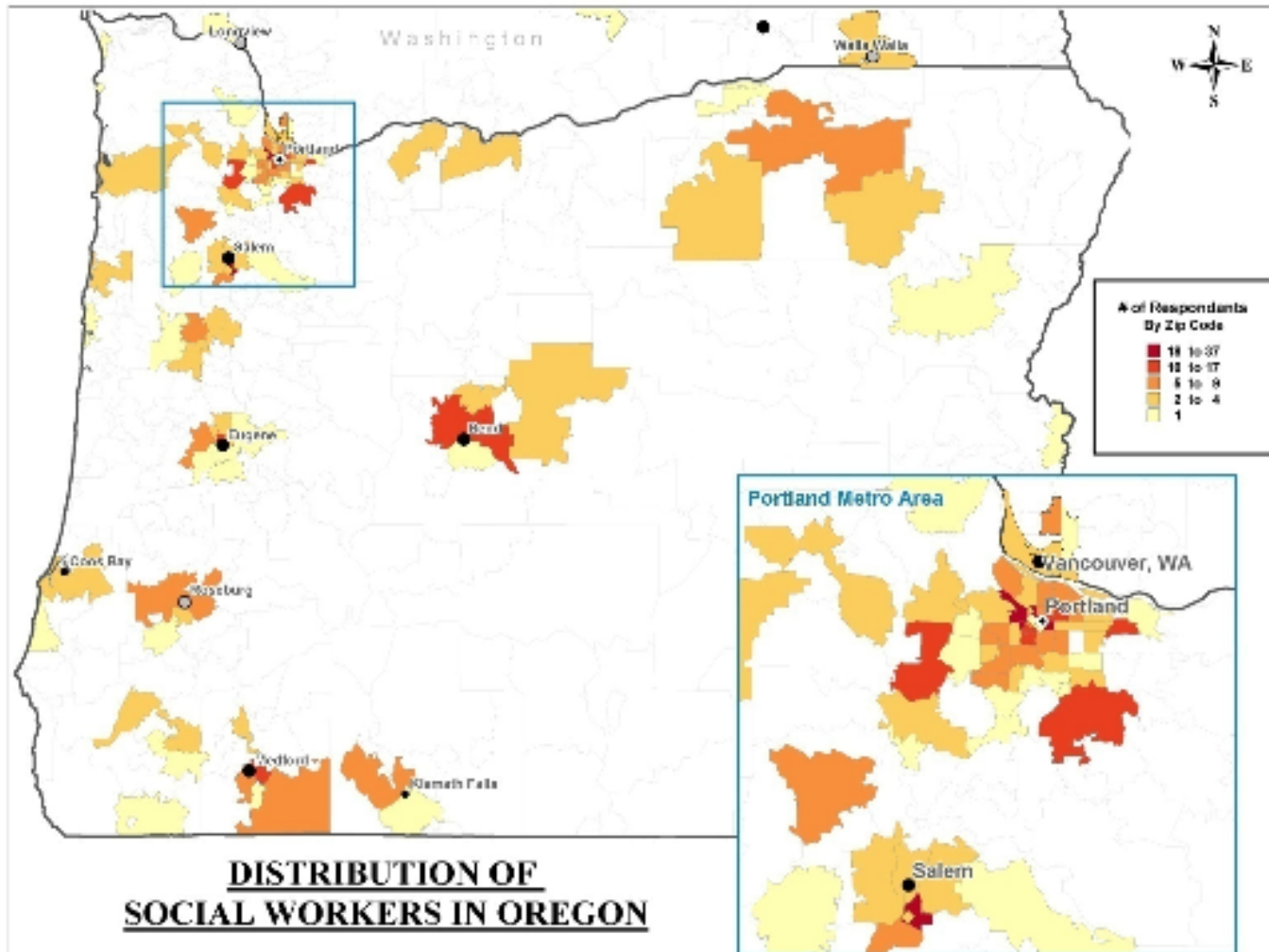
Respondent Demographics

- **838 Respondents**
- **91.9% White (Non-Hispanic)**
 - 3.5% Native American
 - 2.4% Black/African American
 - 2.3% Asian/Pacific Islander
 - 2.1% Hispanic/Latino
 - 0.1% Alaskan Native
 - 1.7% Other
- **84.6 % Female**
- **4.9 % reported a physical disability**
- **11.1% reported a sexual orientation other than heterosexual**
- **91.7% MSW Degree**
- **5.3% were students**

Year of Birth



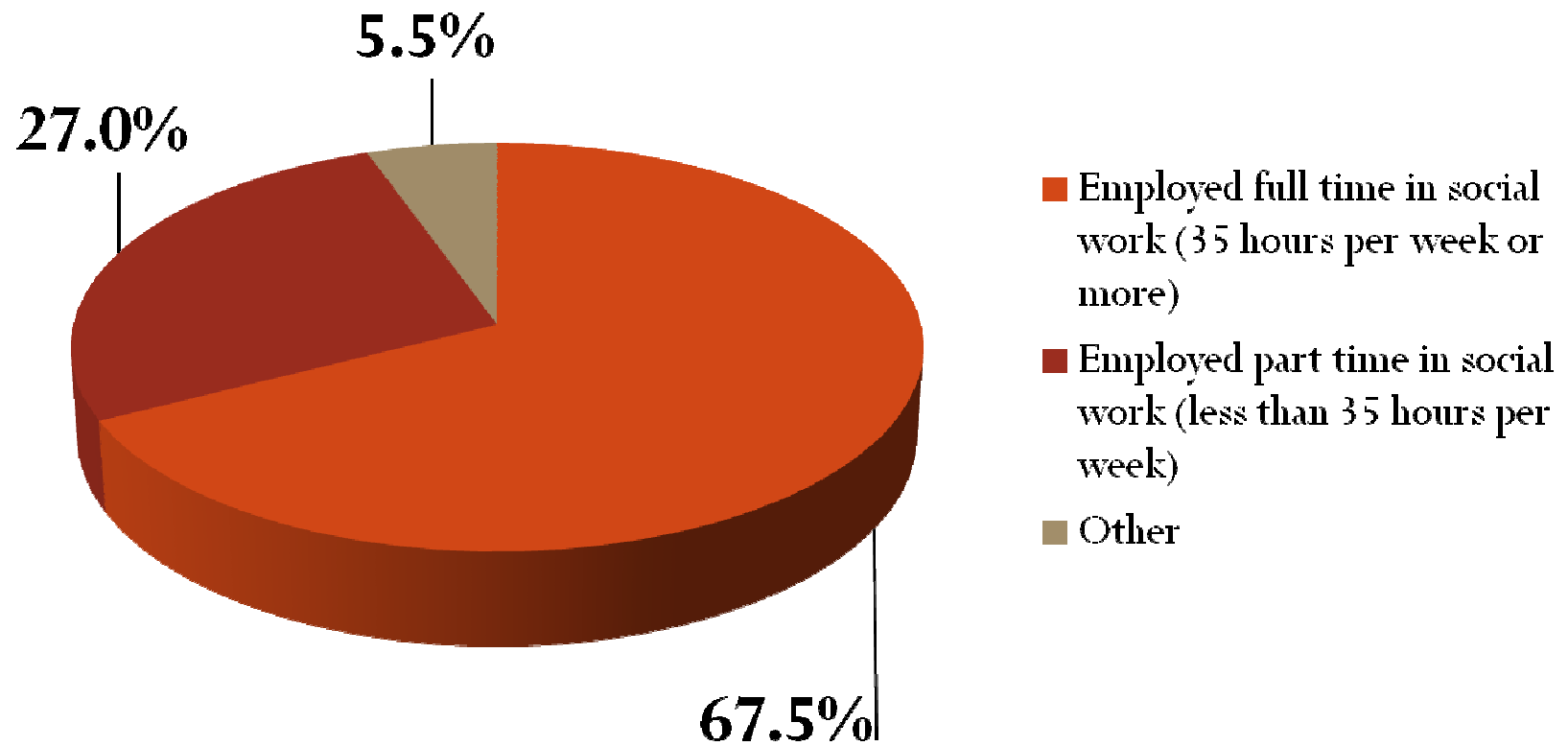
Location of Respondents



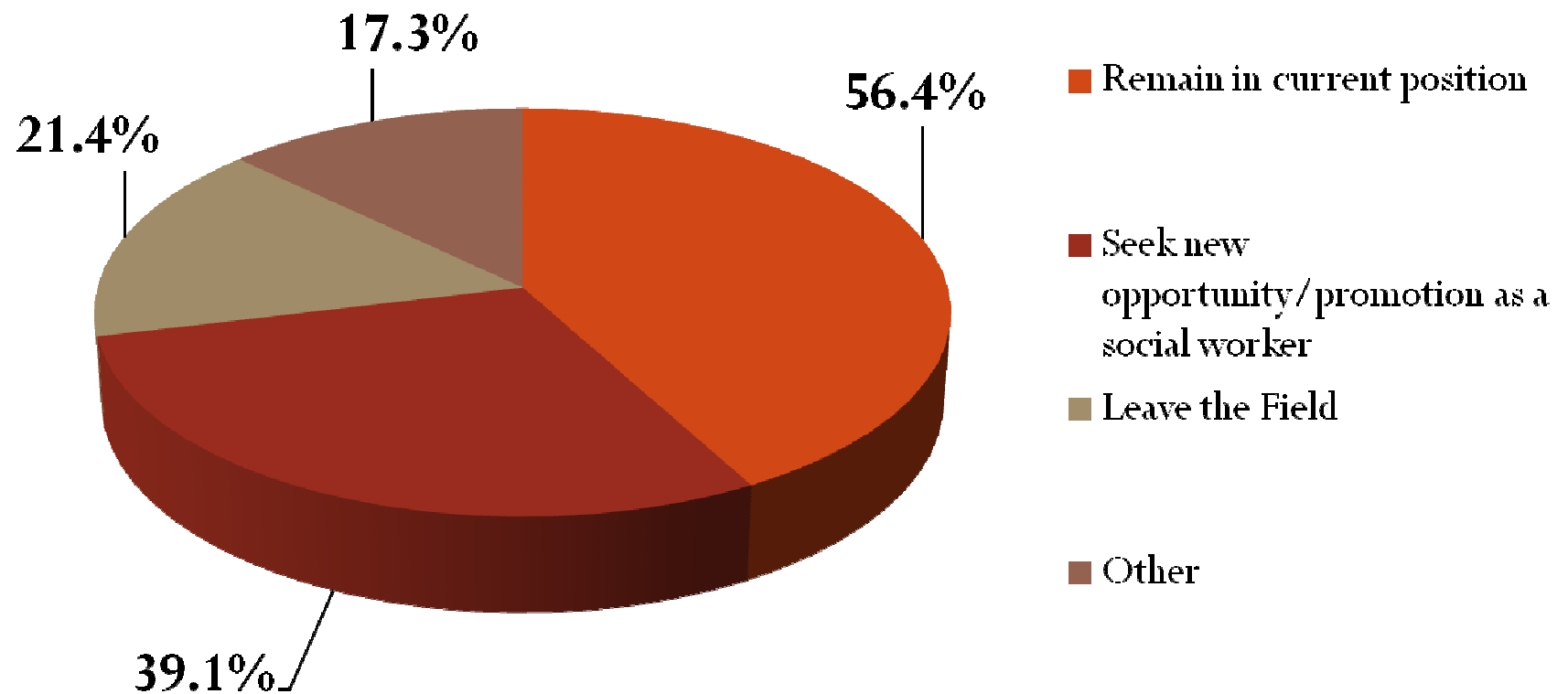

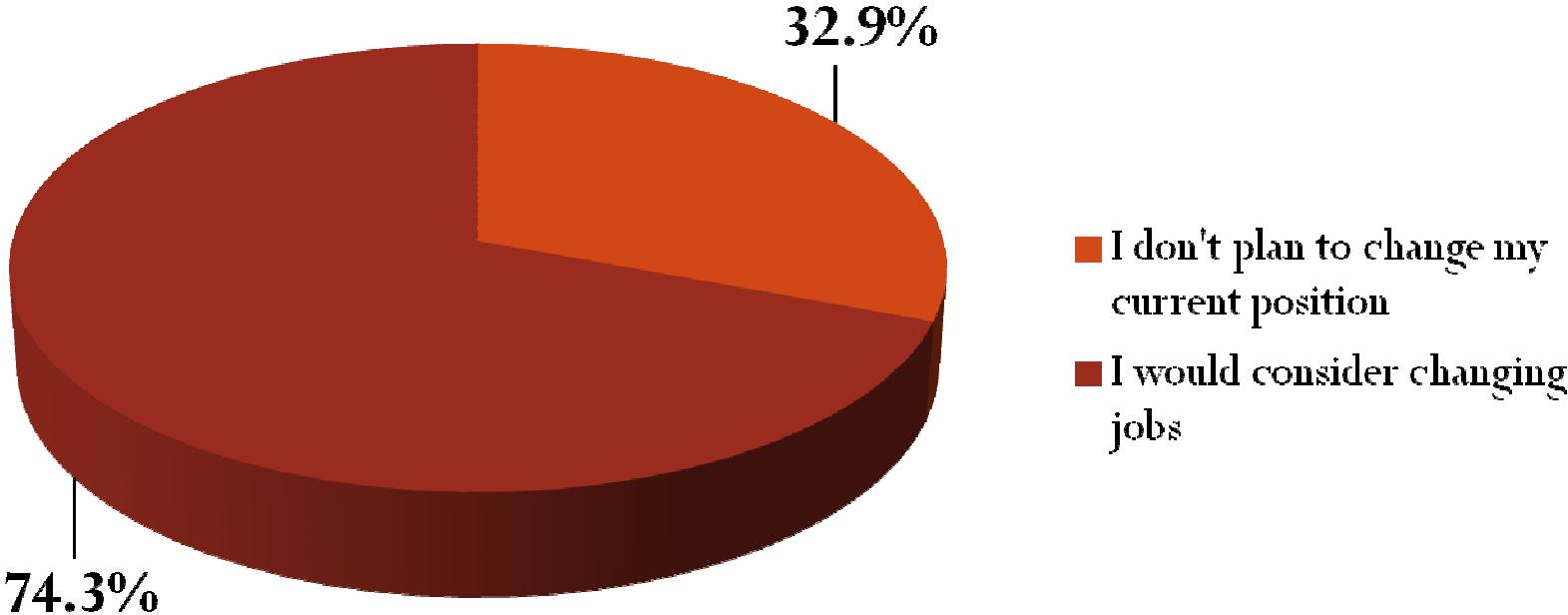
Current Employment Status



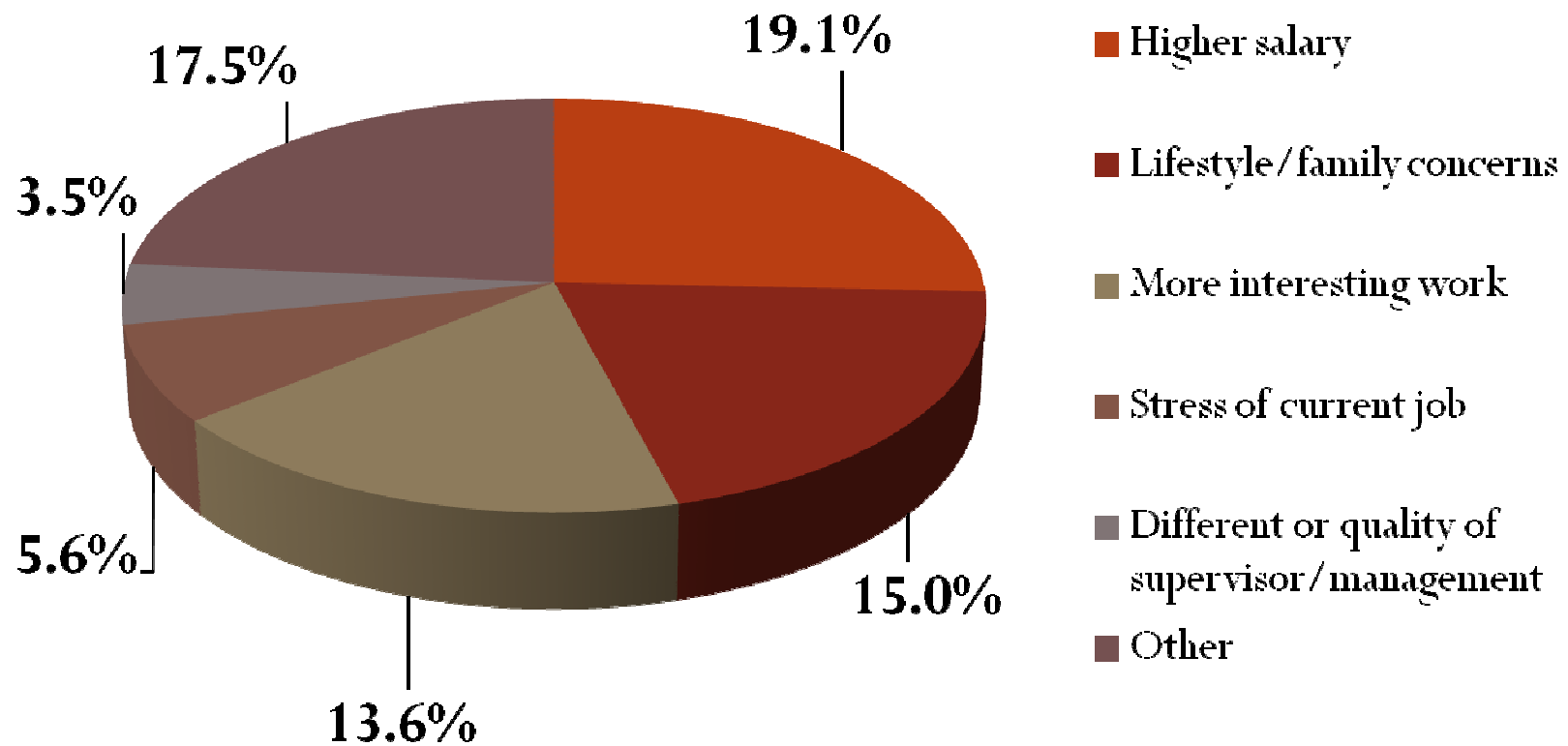
Career plans in Next 3-5 years



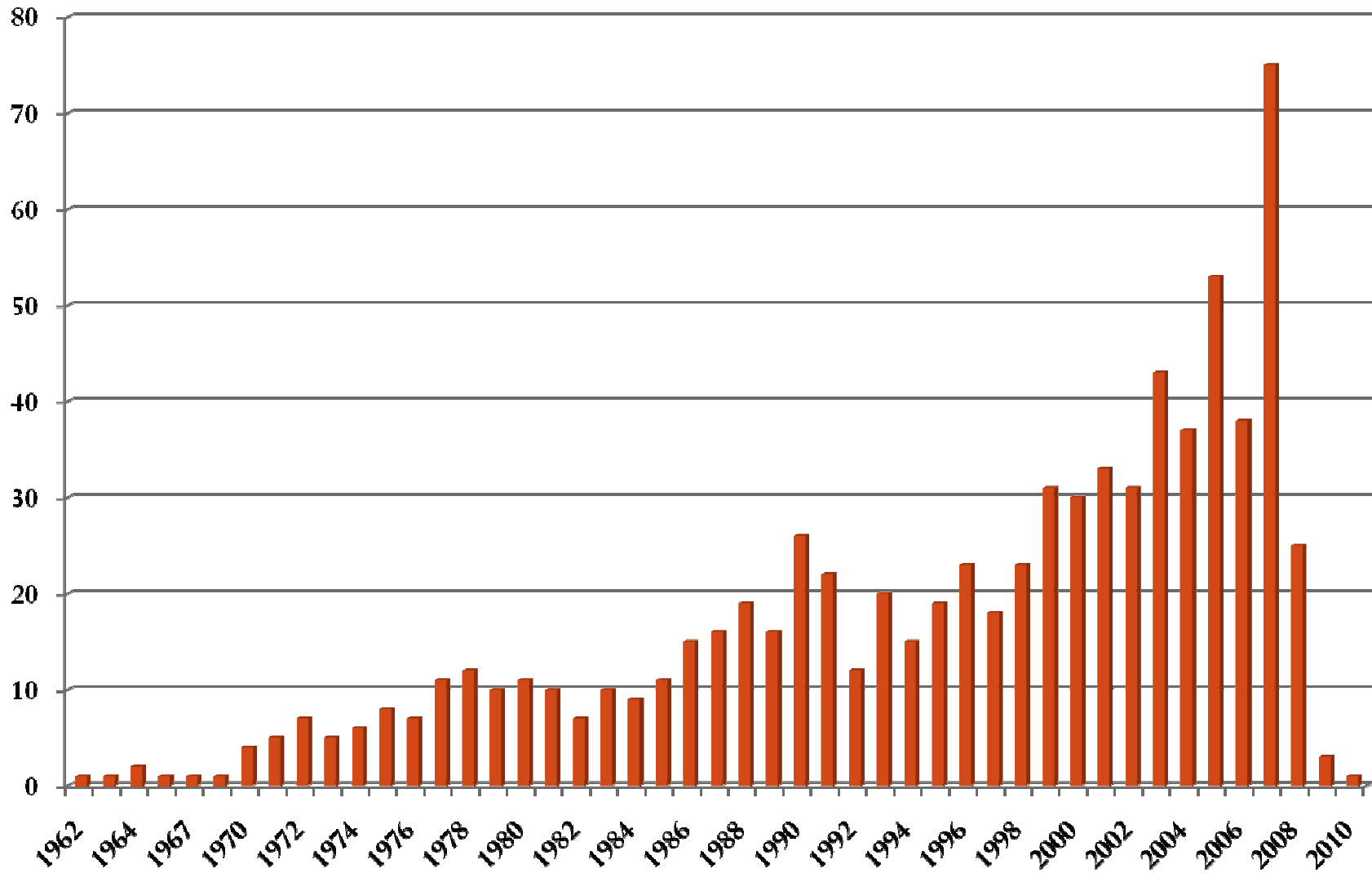
Would you consider changing jobs?



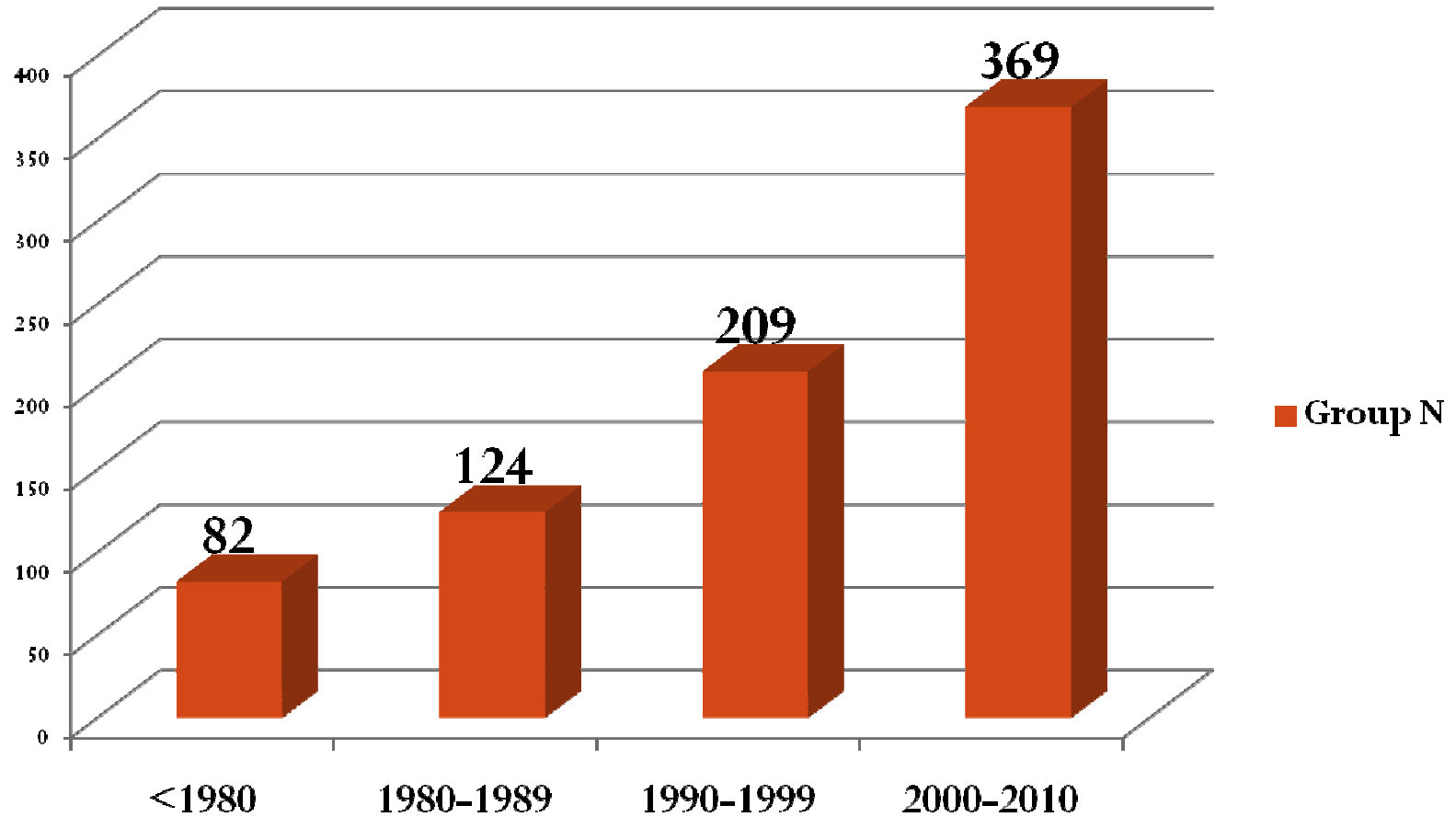
Most important factor that would influence a decision to change current position

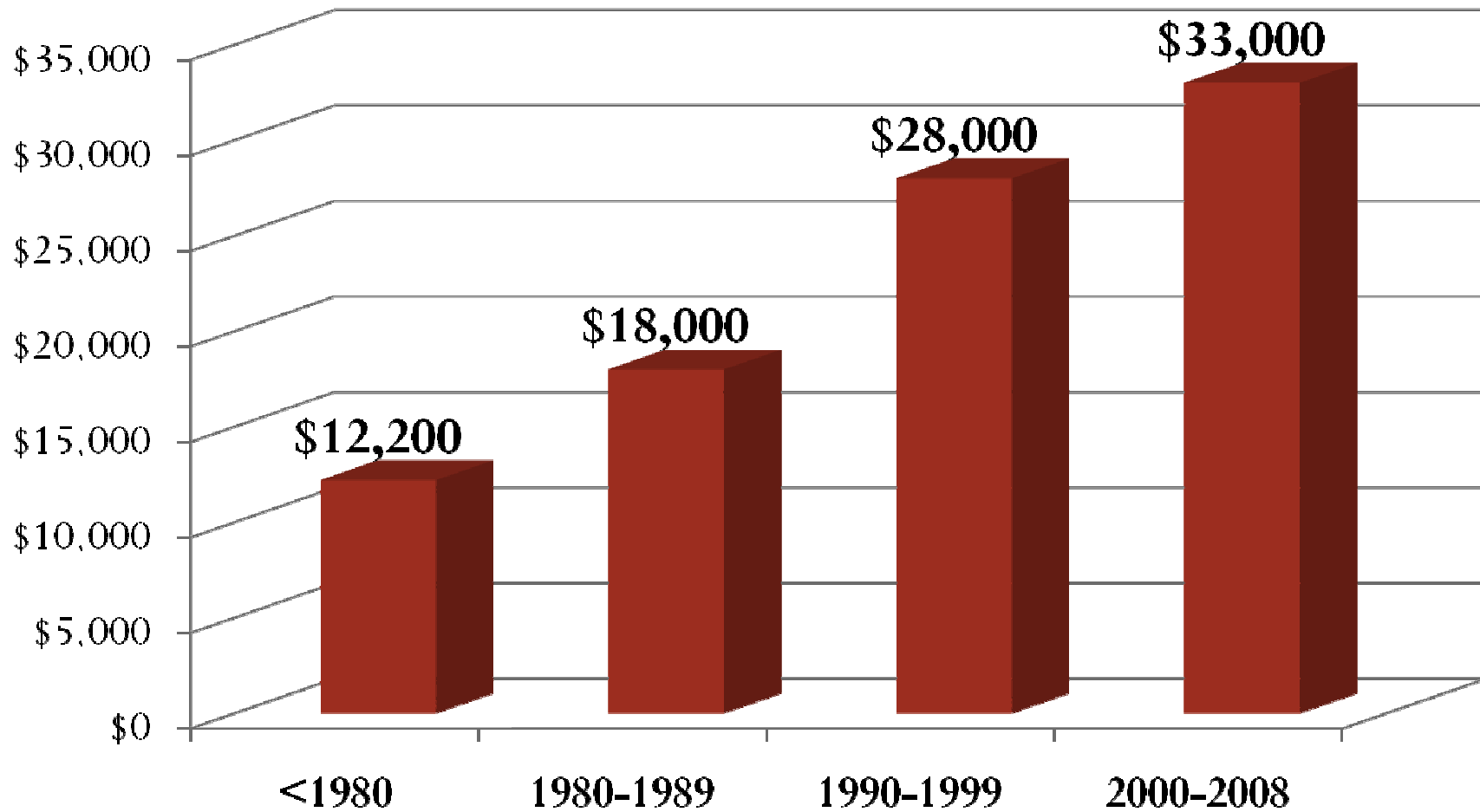

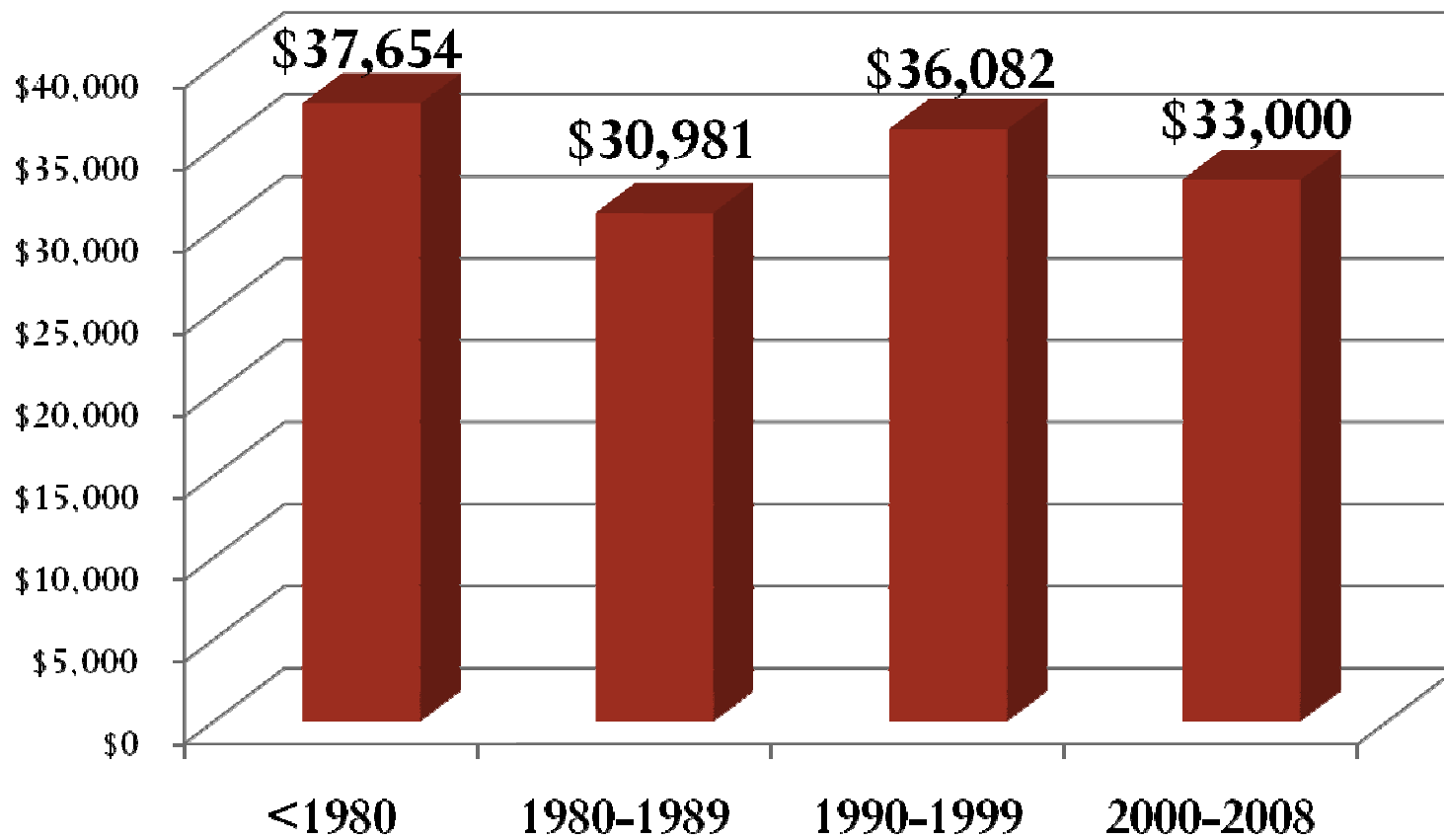


Income at Graduation

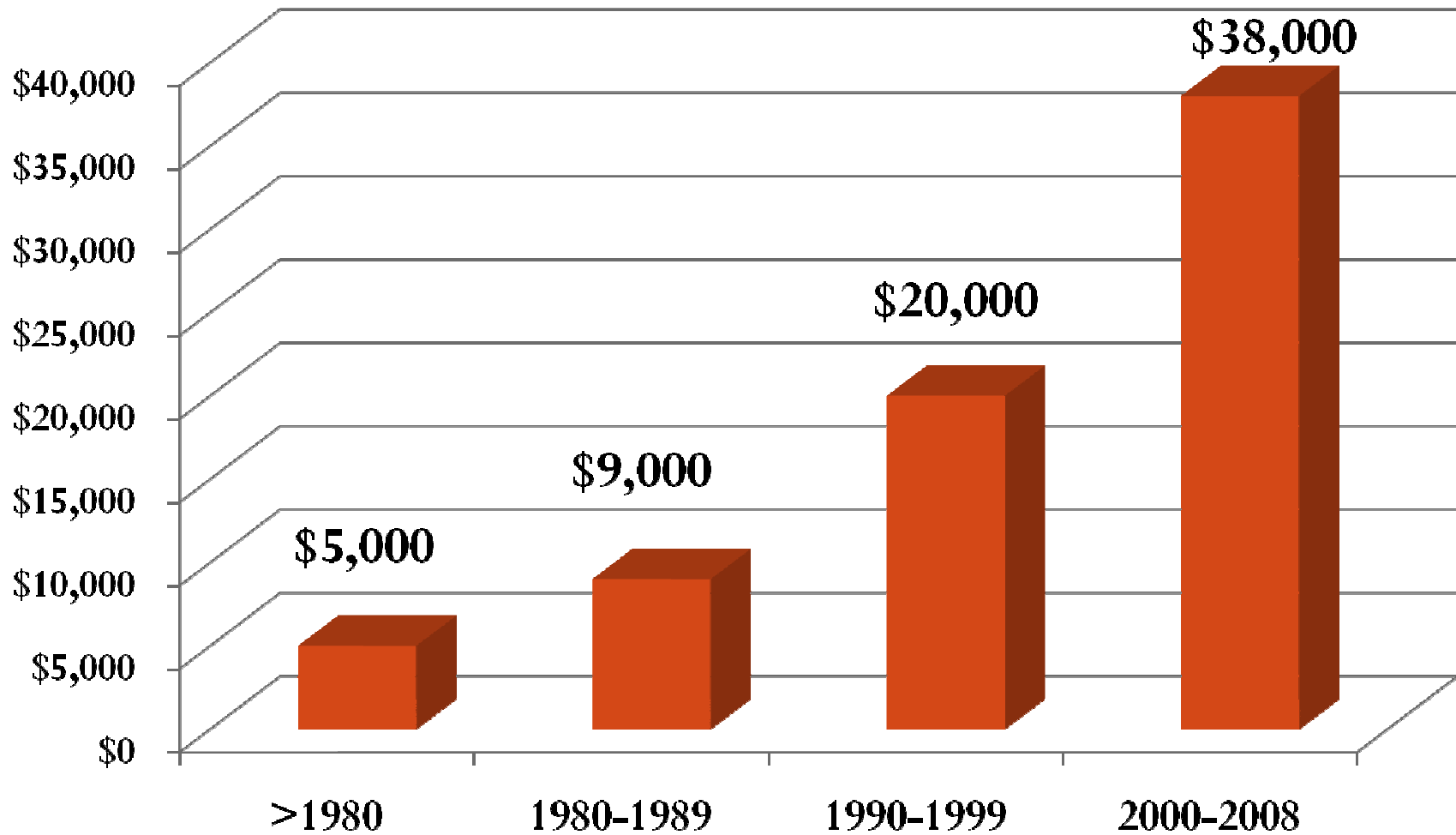
(Median Reported Dollars)



Median Income Adjusted (Median 2008 Dollars)

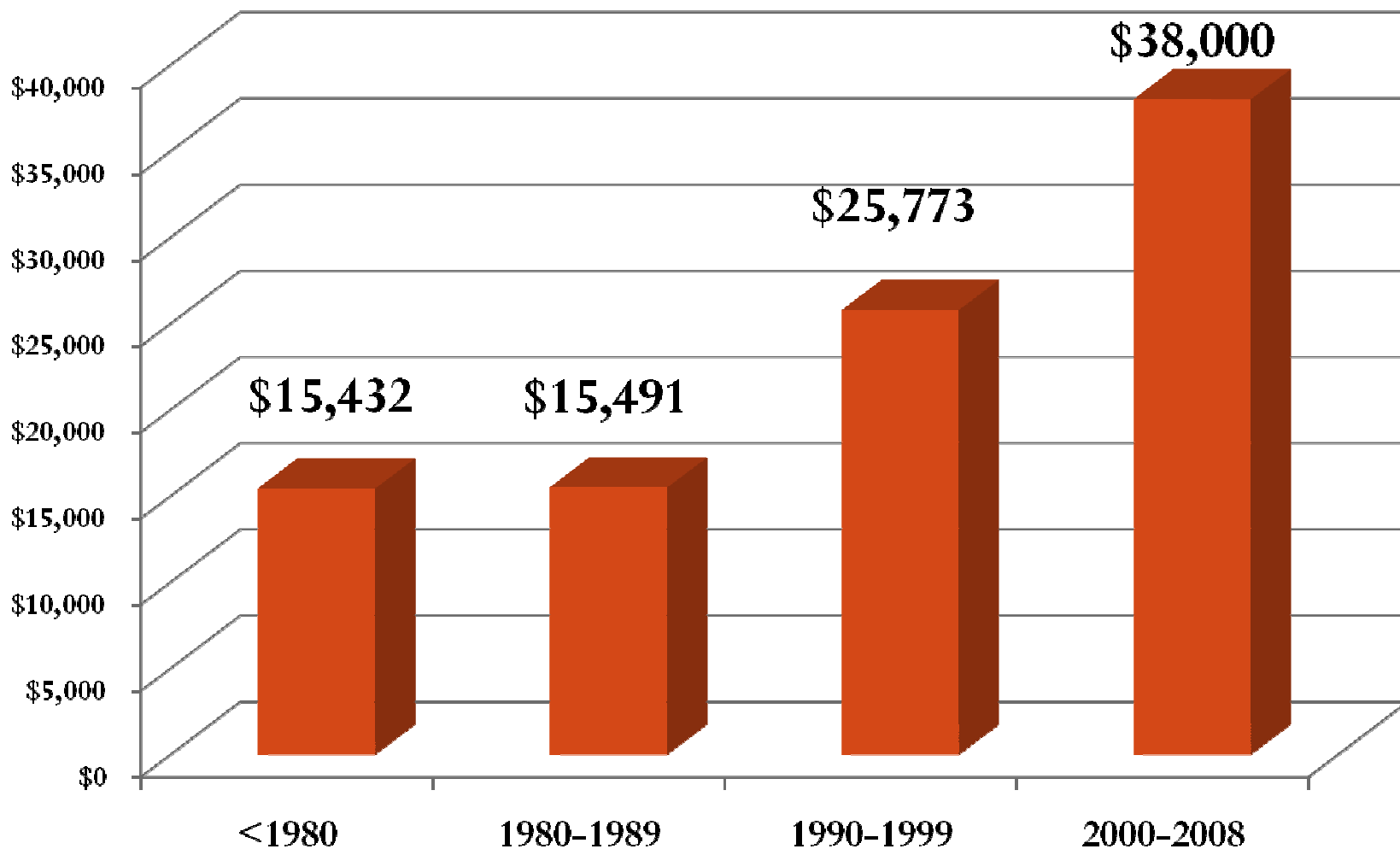


Median Student Loan Debt at Graduation (Reported Dollars)
